the action or process of giving an occupation, activity, or group professional qualities, typically by increasing training or raising required qualifications.

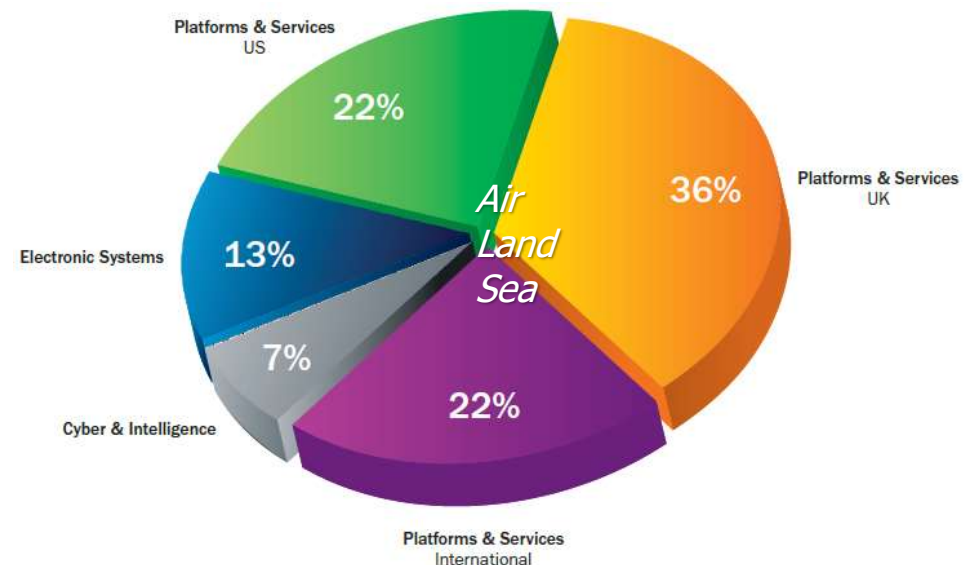
