

Roles of client, sponsor, owner and operator, the governance around them and the delivery strategy





Stakeholder engagement and management

Formal organisational structures, multiple competing interests and community engagement

Risk and uncertainty

Managing technical novelty, the ability to adapt to changing circumstances and complexity





Supply chain integration and coordination

Bringing together multiple systems, procedures and tools, commercial relationships along with technical and managerial integration








Programme management


